



Time To Return To The Altar [December] [Job 8 : 5 - 7]

In case you're still wondering why you are being encouraged to return to the prayer altar at this time of the year; study the scripture above with emphasis on the verse 5, and meditate on the seventh verse. it is important to note, as the Bible says in Ecclesiastes seven, verse eight [A], and I quote from the NKJV, the end of a thing is better than its beginning.

Ecclesiastes 7:8 The end of a thing is better than its beginning; The patient in spirit is better than the proud in spirit.

Points For Meditation

- 2. If the year were a building, whatever spiritual preparation you did could be likened to laying a foundation. Now is the time to give it a good roofing.
- 3. As you can see from the verse 7 of the opening scripture, **Job 8:7** Though your beginning was small, yet your latter end would increase abundantly. the beginning does not always determine the end. It is possible to have started the year small but end it big. You can from today, decide, in mind and in spirit, and believe, that, the end of this year will bring you great successes and victories than its beginning. Challenge yourself, believe that God is able to do, for the Bible says, all things are possible for them that believe, and go to the prayer altar with your supplication.

Note this, YOU CAN DETERMINE HOW YOU WANT THE YEAR TO END WITH PRAYER, FAITH AND A POSITIVE MINDSET. Believe, pray and move, for a better ending of 2024 awaits you.





Points For Prayer

- 1. Thank God for how far He's come with you and lets Him know how grateful you are for keeping you alive until now. If He kept you, then He has something in store for you.
- 2. Speak into each of the remaining days, weeks and months of the year according to your expectations as you pray. Declare the things that are yet to be seen or fulfilled as you pray.
- 3. Continue to knock on doors that are yet to open in 2024, both in prayer and in action. Keep pushing in prayer until the last day of the year. Intensify prayers as the last month of the year approaches.
